

1. Award criteria

Prospective students can apply for scholarships right before matriculation at the university in the jurisdiction of "Studierendenwerk Heidelberg"¹⁾, that

- Haven't reached 30 years of age yet and
- Are matriculating at a university for the first time and
- Aren't receiving or applying other scholarships or support from other establishments
- Are receiving unemployment, social security/welfare, basic income or payments for Asylum Seekers Benefits Act (Asylbewerberleistungsgesetz) or whose parents are receiving child supplement payments according to §6 a, "Bundeskindergeldgesetz"

2. Requirements / procedure

- Previous consultation and personal delivery of the request in the financial aid consultation
- Examination of the request by a case worker of the financial aid office (feedback with the social counseling)
- The request should include a copy of the admission letter with a payment request, a copy of the proof of payment of unemployment, social security/welfare, basic income, child supplement payments according to §6 a, "Bundeskindergeldgesetz" or payments for Asylum Seekers Benefits Act (Asylbewerberleistungsgesetz)
- The application should be made before the begin of the semester so the payment of the semester fee can occur
- The semester fee will be paid directly from the StW HD to the responsible university
- The supervisor of the social department will decide over submitted requests at the suggestion of the case workers of the financial aid department
- There is no legal claim for this scholarship
- When the maximum predetermined funds have been spent, we will not be able to award anymore scholarships
- The applicants will be informed shortly in writing about the rejection or the approval of their application
